John Utley, Jr. was a son of John Utley of Goochland County, Virginia. The parents of Angelica Wade, who bore a son by John Utley, Jr. out of wedlock, have not been determined. Ann Lewis, who married John Utley, Jr., was a daughter of John Lewis of Goochland County.ⁱ

The parentage of John Utley Wade was established in Goochland County Court in February 1739.ⁱⁱ

Angelica Wade Comes into Court and makes Oath that John Utley, junr is the Father of a Male Child named John Born of her body whereupon it is Ordered that a Capias do issue agst the said John Utley returnable to the next Court

On the Complaint of Angelica Wade agt. John Utley Junr. for getting a Bastard Child on her Body the said Angelica having made Oath to the same it is Ordered that the said John do give Security to save the Parish of St. James harmless from the maintainence of said Child and that he pay Costs

On 15 June 1731 John Utley sold the land upon which he lived to Anthony Hoggatt for 100 pounds. The 800 acres were on the north side of James River, partly in Goochland County and partly in Hanover County. The deed was witnessed by Thomas Cookson, John Utley and Robert Willis. There was no wife's signature or release of dower.ⁱⁱⁱ The grantor undoubtedly was John Utley, Sr. and the witness his son, John Utley, Jr., who had to have been 21 to serve as a witness and, so, born before 1710. This is substantiated by the appearance in court in 1735 of John Utley, who was identified as "Jr," to have the age of his negro boy Sampson judged. This record clearly states that John Utley, Jr. owned Sampson and in Sampson is again mentioned in the 1762 will of John Utley, Jr.^{iv}

The land which was sold to Anthony Hoggatt was originally on the Hanover-Henrico county line, and the Henrico portion fell into Goochland when Goochland was erected

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from part of Henrico in 1727 The land was sold to Hoggatt as the result of a court decision which was the final determination of a long standing dispute between Hoggatt and John Utley Sr. John Utley Sr can be tracked back into Henrico County records. John Utley, Sr. spent a lot of time in Court and at one point in 1735, his son John Utley, Jr. bailed him out of jail.^v

The daughters of John Lewis of Goochland County are identified in a deed of division of his land:^{vi}

To all men to whom these presents Shall come Greeting Know ye That whereas John Lewis deceased of the County of Goochland Died possessed of a Tract of Land Containing four hundred and Eighty Acres Lying on the North side of James River and about Dover Church in the County of Goochland We the Subscribers being Joynt Heirs at Law to the said Tract of Land have by the Advice and Consent of Each other Divided the said Tract of Land among us ... to George West and Mary his Wife one hundred and twenty Acres Including the House and Plantation whereon the said John Lewis himself Lived ... to John Dikes and Judith his Wife One hundred and twenty Acres Including the House and plantation whereon Thomas Lawhawn lived ...to John Utley and Anne his Wife one hundred and twenty Acres Including the Houses and plantation whereon the said John Utley now lives ... to James Seay and Lucy his Wife One hundred and twenty Acres Including the Houses and plantation whereon James Magehe lived ... in Witness whereof they have hereunto Interchangably Sett their hands and Seals Nineteenth day of May In the year of our Lord 1747 Signed and delivered in the presence of Us John Cox Elizabeth her X mark Pritchett Allis her X mark Cox

James Seay and Lucy Lewis were identified as residents of Amelia County, Virginia, on 16 November 1747 when they sold her share of her father's land to John Utley:^{vii}

North side of James River in Goochland County on a small Creek called Stony Creek and is ... Land which fell by Heir ship to ... Lucy Seay of the Land of her Father John Lewis Deceased ... bounded as followeth To Wit beginning at a Corner at the said Utleys Spring branch ... up the said branch ...

James and Lucy Seay acknowledged the deed in Goochland County Court on 17 November 1747.

In addition to the land that accrued to him through his marriage to Ann Lewis and the tract that he purchased from James and Lucy Lewis Seay, John Utley, Jr. also acquired two other parcels of land which were legacies in his will. He bought one of undetermined acreage from Nathaniel Holeman and one of fifty acres which was surveyed for him by Peter Jefferson.

The will of John Utley, Jr. was dated 28 December 1761 and proved in Goochland County Court on 16 March 1762. He left 1/3 of the tract of land on which he lived to his wife Ann, who had inherited it from her father John Lewis, plus a negro man named Sam, a bay horse colt, and a black mare. He distributed the remainder of his estate to his nine minor children: William, John, Susannah, Prudence, Jacob, Josiah, Obediah, Hezekiah and Lillie Utley. William and John were described as his two eldest sons with William being the older. He instructed his executors, Matthew Woodson and John Woodson, to provide 18 months schooling for his daughters and 2 1/2 years of education for his sons. He did not mention his illegitimate son John Utley Wade in his will, which was witnessed by John Lewis, Joseph Woodson and John Woodson.^{viii}

In the Name of God Amen I John Utley of the parish of St. James's Northam in the County of Goochland being in a low state of health but of Perfect Sence and Memory do make and Ordain this my Last will and Testament in manner and form Following Vizt. I give my Soul to god who gave it me and my body to the Earth to be Buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Mention'd as to my Worldly Estate which it has pleased God to Endow me with I Give and Dispose of in Manner and form following Vizt. Item, I lend unto my Beloved Wife Ann one third of the Tract of Land which fell to her Father John Lewis on which Tract of land I now Dwell on Dureing her Natural Life. I Likewise lend unto my Beloved wife one Negro Man Called Sam dureing her Natural Life and after her Decease the said Negro Sam to be sold and the Money ariseing from Such Sale to be Equally Devided among my nine Children hereafter Mention'd to them and their Heirs for Ever. Item. I Lend unto my wife one bay horse Colt and one Black Mare called Pleasure dureing her Natural life. Item. I Give unto my two Eldest Sons

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William and John the Tract of land which I bought of Nathaniel Holeman I likewise give unto them my two Sons William & John fifty Acres of land which I took up and Survey'd by Pet. Jefferson to them and their Heirs forever if Either of them die under Age and not married the Survivor to have his lot of them beforemention'd the land to be divided Equally in Quantity and Quality. I give unto my Eldest Son William one bay horse Colt Called Spark and one Gun to him and his Heirs forever. I give unto my Second son John my Saddle and Colt which I imagine my Gray Mare is with Fold off Call'd Pleasure but if the Fold shou'd miscarry I then give the said Mare to him my said Son John and his Heirs forever. Item. I give unto my two Sons Jacob and Josiah the Tract of land which I now dwell on which formerly was the property of John Lewis and at his Death the Land fell to my wife as Coe Heirs with her Sisters one third of this Tract of Land I have lent unto my wife and at her Death her thirds to Descend to my two Sons Jacob and Josiah to be Equally Divided Between them in quantity & quality to them and their Heirs forever. but if Either of them shou'd die before they arive to the Age of Twenty one years & not Married the Survivor to take his lot of them my two Sons last Mention'd & their Heirs forever. Item. I give unto my two Sons Obediah and Ezekiah the land wch. I purchased of James Sea and Lucy his wife which land fell to the said Lucy as a Coe Heir with her Sisters at the Death of John Lewis her Father aforemention'd and by the said Sea & his wife the land was Sold to me to be Equally Divided in Quantity and Quality if Either of them my two Sons die underage and not married the Survivor of them my Sons Obediah & Ezekiah Enjoy the others lot and their Heirs forever. Item. my will is that my wife enjoy only one third of the Tract of land which I've will'd to my two Sons Jacob and Josiah dureing her Natural Life which afore is will'd to her and that my four Other Sons Enjoy their lands will'd them without their Mother Claiming any Right or Dower in their Lands for what I've above Assigned her, I think is full Sufficient for her and no more allot'd by my will Item. my Desire is that two of my Negro Nam'd Sampson and Juda be sold by my Executors Matthew Woodson and John Woodson and the money Ariseing from the sale to be laid out in a young Negro boy I think it is not a Miss to Sett the Largest Debts that due to me which Sums following is justly due to me William Johnson Ten pounds from June Last Richard Davis Hinds Eleaven Pounds for which he promises to pay Interest for from August Last due from John Lewis and Interest thereon Since May 1761 four pounds Ten Shillings wch. said Sums due by the persons above Mention'd and about fifteen pounds which I have in the House to be laid out in a young Negro to be bought by my Executors Matthew Woodson and John Woodson for the Benefit of my Children. Item. I give unto my nine Children William John Susanna Prudence Jacob Josiah Obediah Ezekiah and Lillea five Negroes and there Increase Named Tabb phillis Sara Antony & Jenny to be Equally divided Between my nine Children and their Heirs forever. Item. my Desire is that all my children be maintain'd out of my Estate and Eighteen Months Schooling to Each of my Daughters and two years & a half to Each of my sons at the Expencc of my Estate and if my two Executors after a Reasonable Maintainance of the rest of my Family shall be able to Clear any Money what Money so Rais'd by the Labour

of my Slaves they shall Injoy without being Accountable to the rest of my Children they being Answering to the appraisement of my Estate Except what I have order'd to be sold untill my youngest Child shall Arive to the Age of Twenty one years or Married at which time the Estate to be Equally devided my Nine Children and there Heirs forever, my Desire is that four of my stock of cattle be Sold and the Money Apply'd to the best Advantage that my two Exrs. shall think proper for the Benefit of my Estate if the money which I have Order'd to be laid out in two young Negro be not Sufficiant which I've Order'd John Woodson and Mattw. Woodson to buy for my Children that they shall Sell Such things as Can be best Spar'd of my Estate to Enable to make the purchase of the two Negro and the two Negros so purchased to be Equally Divided among my nine Children and their Heirs forever I Desire that all my household furniture be Equally divided among my wife and nine Children and there Heirs forever. Item. all the rest of my Estate both Real and personal I desire may be divided Among my nine Children share and Share alike and their Heirs forever, if any of my Children die under age & not married there part of the Estate to Decend to the Survivors Except land which I've before order'd it shall decend if any of my Children shall Disagree in the Division of there Estates such case's shall be Left to the three Eldest Majestrates of the peace where Such Efficts shall be that cant be agreed on & the said Majestrates determination shall be final and the party that shall Refuse standing by the determination of the sd. Majestrates shall Loose what is in dispute I do Constitute and Appoint my Wife Executrix together with my Six son like John Woodson & Matthew Woodson Executors of this my last will and Testament Revoking all former will in Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this 28th day December MDCCLXI Sign'd Seal'd and Deliver'd In presence of

An inventory of the estate of John Utley, Jr. was dated 27 April 1762.^{ix}

The last four children of John Utley, Jr. and Ann Lewis and some of their grandchildren were baptized by the Reverend William Douglas in Goochland County, who also performed the marriages of John's bastard son John Utley Wade and their two eldest sons:^x

The Reverend William Douglas came to St. James Northam Parish, Goochland County,

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on 12 October 1750. On 15 September 1753 he began keeping a record, which he stated was the first record kept for the parish, of marriages that he performed. He obtained a ledger in 1756 that became a permanent register for the parish and was maintained by him until his death in 1798. In 1756 he inserted many of the prior marriages that he had conducted and, at the request of some of the parents of the congregation, he also added some birth records going back to 1705. The church for St. James Parish was Dover Church which was the first church in Goochland County. It was authorized to be constructed on 11 February 1720 at a cost of 54,990 pounds of tobacco. It was to be 50 feet long and 24 feet wide.^{xi}

Dover Church is on Route 621 about three-quarters of a mile north of the village of Manakin at the intersection of 621 and Route 6 from Richmond to the town of Goochland. Manakin is about thirteen miles from Richmond and twelve miles from Goochland. There is a St. James Church on Route 649 about one-half mile south of Route 6 and two miles east of Manakin.^{xii}

The Reverend Douglas made no record of any deaths in the Utley family. The possible death dates of William, Lillie, Obediah and Josiah Utley were taken from an index of probate records of Goochland County:

John Utley III, who married Nancy Clarkson, was born "about 1746," served in the Revolutionary War and died on 12 November 1824.^{xiii} Josiah Utley, son of John Utley III and Nancy Clarkson, was born in Goochland County, Virginia, on 26 February 1774, married Nancy Barker and died on 07 January 1853 in Mercer County, Kentucky. William Thomas Utley, son of James Utley and Elizabeth Hardwick, was born on 20 March 1838 in Mercer County, Kentucky, married Hannah Graham, who was born in 1845 in Indiana, died on 18 January 1921 and is buried at Sandusky, Lee County, Iowa.^{xiv}

Hezekiah (Ezekial) Utley and Private William Utley of Goochland County also participated in the Revolutionary War.^{xv}

It appears that four of the sons of John Utley, Jr. were taxed in Goochland County in 1782:^{xvi}

Although known records do not disclose any association by John Utley, Jr. with his bastard son John Utley Wade, it seems that his legitimate and illegitimate issue did move in the same social circles. Castleton Wade, son of John Utley Wade and Alice Woodrum, who was born on 01 January 1765, married Judith Chancellor in Goochland County on 01 February 1787 with Julius Chancellor as surety on the bond, which was dated 31 January 1787. John Utley IV, son of John Utley III and Ann Clarkson who was born on 27 November 1776, got a bond to marry Ally Chancellor in Goochland County on 01 October 1803 with David Utley as surety.^{xvii}

15 Dec 1777. John Utley and Elizabeth Gordon with Joel Ragland as surety. The Reverend William Douglas certified that John Utley was born 26 Dec 1755 (This was entered or transcribed in error since Josiah Utley was born on 26 December 1755 and married Elizabeth Gordon.)

06 Nov 1790. John Lewis and Sally Utley, daughter of William Utley, with Stephen Crouch as surety. Married 06 Nov by William Webber with witnesses Richard Lewis and Phil Webber

26 Dec 1795. Obadiah Utley and Jane Willis were married by the Reverend William Webber

14 Mar 1798. Reuben Utley and Elizabeth Utley with John Utley as surety

17 Feb 1800. Thomas Tinsley and Sarah Utley, daughter of Obadiah Utley with Charles F. Jordan as surety

01 Oct 1803. John Utley, Jr. and Ally Chancellor with David Utley as surety

10 Jun 1804. Ezekiah Blalock and Martha Utley, daughter of Obediah Utley, with William Powell as surety

31 Jul 1811. Thomas Lane and Catherine Utley, daughter of Hezekiah Utley, with Obediah Utley as surety

Joel Ragland, who was surety for Josiah Utley and Elizabeth Gordon in 1777, must have been related to Mary Ragland (Ragline) who married William Utley in 1766. Joel Ragland had land in Franklin County, Virginia, which he sold to John Utley Wade in 1792.^{xviii}

Jacob Utley may have moved to Kentucky, where the wife (name unknown from broken tombstone) of a Jacob Utley died in 1819.^{xix}
