In case any errors were there [just to see if I read the report] I will add info now:

1. Hardy Albert Campbell & Martha Elizabeth Myers were both born in Warren County, TN and after the formation of Grundy County, were counted there. Your program listed Grainger. Truth is the Fults home had the county line through it. My mother would laugh and say if she had been born a couple of feet over she would have been a Grundy County baby. [Your program made I Grainger County.
2. I have never seen where John Windle Kite wife was a Miller. And I do have a Kite book. Never seen where John Fults mother was a Kite and really thought she might be an Oyler.
3. I never heard Minnie Lynn Fults that wed grandpa had a middle name Daisy.
4. David Lawrence's wife was Caroline Mabry daughter of Thomas Mabry.
5. There is no mention of "Strong" in our Alexander Martin's name. The only "proof" that James Martins dad was an Alexander Martin is from land records transactions but no mention of relationships.

All of this shows me why I should document. A lot of my information came from people instead of printed sources.

In looking at your info on internet I was really impressed with the genealogist in Nashville who worked on the Goodson family. I have worked locally on that name also. A bootlegger named Zolly Goodson lived on dad's farm in Rogers Hollow one time. Once he was fined and paid it in pennies [picture in paper].
